A PROSPECTIVE ANALYTICAL STUDY TO DETERMINE THE OUTCOME OF GLOVE RUBBER SETON FOR TREATMENT OF COMPLEX FISTULA IN ANO.

BACKGROUND AND OBJECTIVES

Complex fistulas have complex tracts, involving the sphincters, horse-shoe tracts, or recurrent. They have a cryptoglandular etiology. They are known for recurrence. Sphincter function preservation with elimination of the fistulous tract is ideal goal. Glove rubber seton is an easily accessible and promising modality.

Objectives – complete healing time and time taken for seton drop.

MATERIALS AND METHOD

97 patients were admitted in Vydehi Medical College And Research Centre, Bangalore with complex fistula in ano and underwent glove rubber seton fistulotomy. Following recovery from surgery patients were discharged and followed up weekly on out-patient basis. A loop of cuff cut from a sterile surgical glove was fashioned into seton by tying to silk ties to each pole. The silk tie assists in passing the glove rubber cuff into the fistulous tract. With desired tension, the two ends of rubber seton are secured with a fresh silk tie. Weekly follow up done to assess the functioning of the Seton, drop of Seton, Post operative pain, Incontinence, Healing and Recurrence. Results to be analyzed with statistical methods.

RESULTS

The outcomes are as follows: The mean time taken for seton drop is 16.98 1.15 days [15 – 19]. The mean complete healing time is 42.46 1.77 days [39 – 46]. Mean pain VAS score on POD-1 is 3.53 0.50, POD-7 is 1.61 0.49, POD-14 is 1.09 0.29. None of the patients had lasting incontinence.

INTERPRETATION & amp; CONCLUSION

Glove rubber seton fistulotomy is cost effective with minimal postoperative pain, no lasting incontinence and good results.

Dr. Vikhyath Cutaneous sarcoidosis in an old Postsurgical Scar

Infiltration of pre-existing scars by sarcoidal granulomas is uncommon. The pathogenesis remains bizzare and the significance of this rather peculiar symptom remains neglected. 3-4% of the patients have involvement of scars with or without systemic involvement i.e. 1.9/1 lakh population with female preponderance. Post-surgical and post-traumatic scars are known to be commonly involved.

A 48 year old female presented with complaints of dull aching, non-radiating pain in the right upper abdomen, at the previous scar site of open cholecystectomy(20years back). H/o low grade intermittent fever of 3 episodes over 1 month associated with myalgia.

Per abdomen examination revealed a 6x0.5cm hypertrophic right subcostal scar with scar tenderness and local rise of temperature. Rest of the systemic examination was unremarkable.

Ultrasound Abdomen and Pelvis- 1cc-4cc collection in the lateral end of the scar. Pre-operative chest radiograph showed normal lung fields.

Patient underwent Exploration and scar revision under GA. Histopathlogical examination -Dermis displayed abundant confluent, non-necrotising, non-caseating granulomas. Few multinucleated giant cells displayed asteroid bodies establishing a diagnosis of sarcoidosis with no evidence of any foreign bodies or atypical cells.

Head to toe re-examination showed no signs of systemic sarcoidosis with normal levels of Vitamin D3 and S.Calcium on further investigation.

Triamcinalone infiltration of the revised surgical scar was performed. A routine follow up showed a heathy surgical scar healed by primary intention with no signs of local inflammation or tenderness.

Sarcoidosis in India is uncommon and cutaneous sarcoidosis is most commonly seen along with systemic involvement. Incidence of isolated scar sarcoid is 2.9-5.4% with a possibility of progression to systemic sarcoid. Recent onset of localised changes in long standing scars, traumatic or surgical in origin should arise a suspicion of sarcoidosis and a short course of steroids to be considered at the earliest sign of inflammation/systemic involvement.
